Regarding amendments in Chartered Accountants Ordinance, 1961 the President informed that the proposed Amendment Bill was with the Cabinet Committee and he was hopeful that it would soon get through. He stressed that the Institute would continue close liaison with SECP, SBP and FBR as well as maintaining close contacts with IFAC and other international bodies to maintain high professional standards.

he 48th Annual General Meeting of the Institute was held on Wednesday October 28, 2009 at 6:00 PM in Islamabad. In his opening remarks President ICAP Abdul Rahim Suriya informed members about the MOU signed between the Institute and the Federal Board of Revenue for tax audit. He said that tax audit will open up opportunities for audit professionals. He quoted examples of success stories of tax audit in India and Turkey.

The President also informed members that the Council was in the process of revamping ICAP's education system. He said a major priority for the Council was to review the syllabus in line with IFAC's International Education Standards, developing study packs for students, and introducing a permanent credit system expected to be applicable for examinations after December 2009.

He further added that for Continuing Professional Development of members the Institute is considering more video conferencing and online collaboration with virtual universities.

He announced that the Institute was aiming to achieve a 100 percent IFRS compliance status in the near future. He said that because of high education standards and quality training, our Chartered Accountants were in demand all over the world and were treated at par with qualified accountants from developed countries. He said that about 1200 Pakistani Chartered Accountants are working in the Middle East, Europe and the United States.

The Education & Examination Task Force under the chairmanship of Syed Mohammad Shabbar Zaidi, FCA, had invited the southern region members to gather views on Training Outside Practice i.e. Training in Industry. IAASB Releases New Tools to Support Clarity ISA Adoption and Implementation

Each "ISA Module" consists of a brief video presentation, a set of slides, and supporting notes that explain the key principles of, and major changes in, individual ISAs. The support modules include the implications for audits of small- and medium-sized entities.
