
In compliance to HEC letter No. (No.15-54/Coord/2019/HEC/(SAD)/451) dated June 19, 2021, and your office's letter No. ICAP/DET/002655/85157 dated June 23, 2021, SZABIST is pleased to offer the fast-track program of BS (A&F) 2.5 years, specifically designed for the CAF qualified students, recognized by ICAP.

BS (A&F) program at Szabist is a four-year (eight semester) program and consists of 144 credit hours of teaching (**Program Structure provided in Table 1**). Students are required to complete 46 courses and a 6 credit hours of final year project (to be offered over last two semester). With reference to the HEC letter, the Faculty of Management Sciences has designed a 2.5-year BS(A&F) degree program (84 Credit Hours – 26 Courses and 6 Credit Hour final year project to be offered over two semesters) to eligible candidates (**Program Structure provided in Table 2**). 
