

Minimum recommended specifications and the general requirements for the laptops to be used in center-based exams of ICAP

Device	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only laptops are allowed. • Minimum specifications of the permissible laptops are defined below.
Processor	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Intel Core i3 1.0 GHz or similar
RAM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • OS specified minimum RAM or 8 GB, whichever is higher
Hard disk	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Type: Solid-State Drive (SSD) • Minimum free space: 20 GB
Display resolution	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1024 x 768
Operating system (OS)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Windows 10 or above (32-bit or 64-bit) • Mac OS X Yosemite 10.10 or above (excluding beta versions)
Internet browser	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Google Chrome Version 82 or above
Browser settings	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • JavaScript must be enabled. • Internet cookies must be enabled. • Any pop-up blocking setting(s) must be disabled.
Firewall	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Taking exams on a personal laptop is recommended as office laptops generally have more restrictions that may prevent successful exam delivery. • If a strict firewall policy with antivirus on local setup is deployed on the laptop to be used for taking the exam, then examinees will need to allow access to the following URL: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – *.sonet.com.au
Wi-Fi Adapter	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The laptop must have a functional Wi-Fi adapter as connectivity to the internet will be provided through Wi-Fi access points.
Power	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The battery of the laptop should be fully charged and capable of providing backup power for at least 45 minutes. • Must bring the laptop's charger and power cord to the examination hall.
