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INTRODUCTION

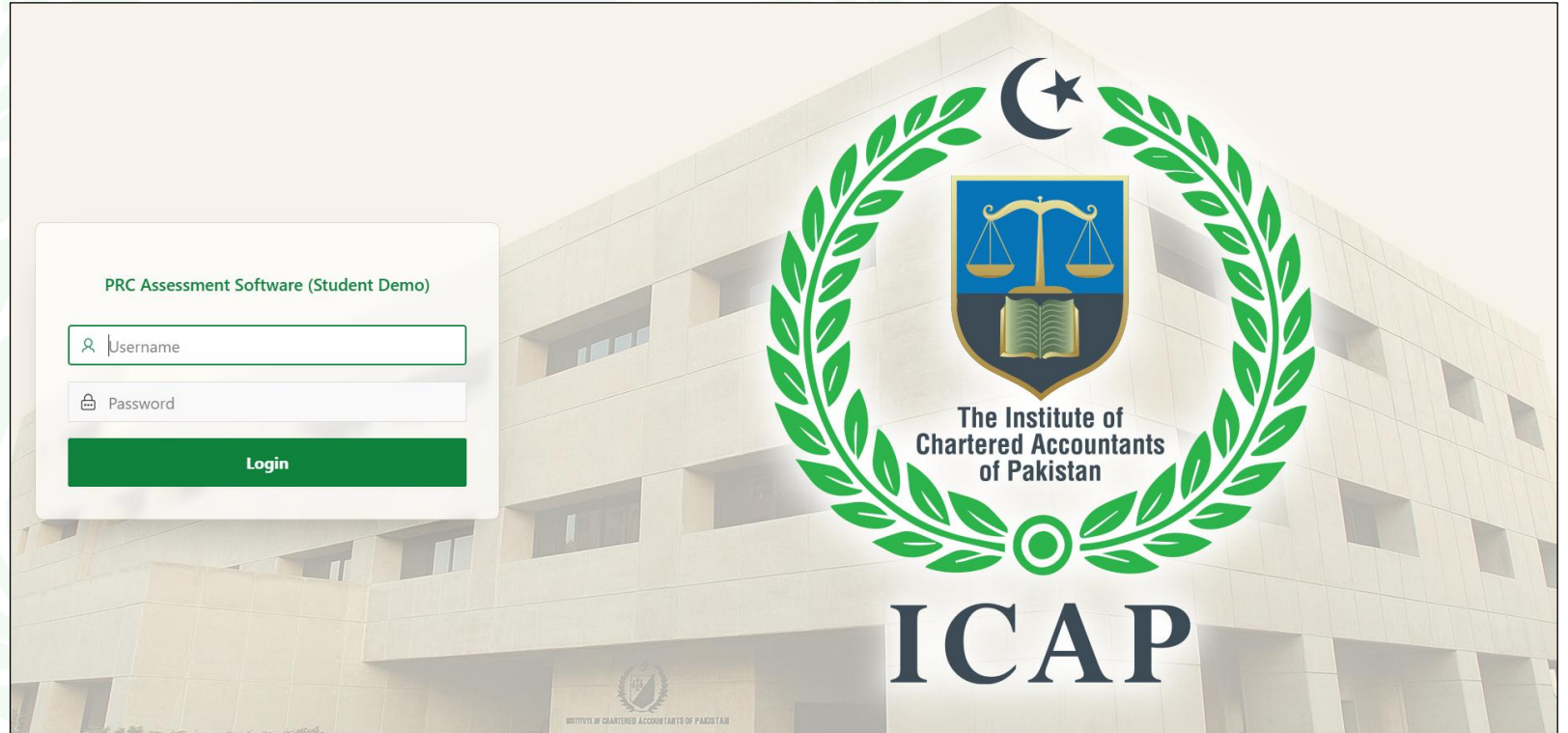
This document provides guidance on the use of the new examination software for QAT, PRC, and Integrated Modules. It is designed to help you understand the software environment, its key functions, and the types of questions you will encounter during assessments.

To support preparation, ICAP has made model papers/practice tests available in the secured area of ICAP's Website. These resources replicate the actual examination interface, allowing you to practice navigation, explore available tools, and build confidence ahead of your exam.

By reviewing this guidance and attempting the practice tests, you will be better equipped to use the software effectively and manage your examination with greater ease.

LOGIN SCREEN

The very first window that appears is the Login Screen. Here you need to type your Username and Password, which will be provided on your Admit Card. Both fields are case-sensitive, so you must enter your credentials exactly as shown on your Admit Card.



INSTRUCTIONS PAGE

After successfully entering the exam, the system will automatically direct you to the Instructions Page. This page provides important guidelines about the examination process and the use of the software. You must confirm that you have read and understood the instructions before proceeding to the first question. Skipping this step may lead to confusion during the exam.

The **countdown timer** starts on this page. Once you press **Continue**, you move to the first question. The Continue button is available both at the top left corner and at the bottom right corner of the Instructions Page.

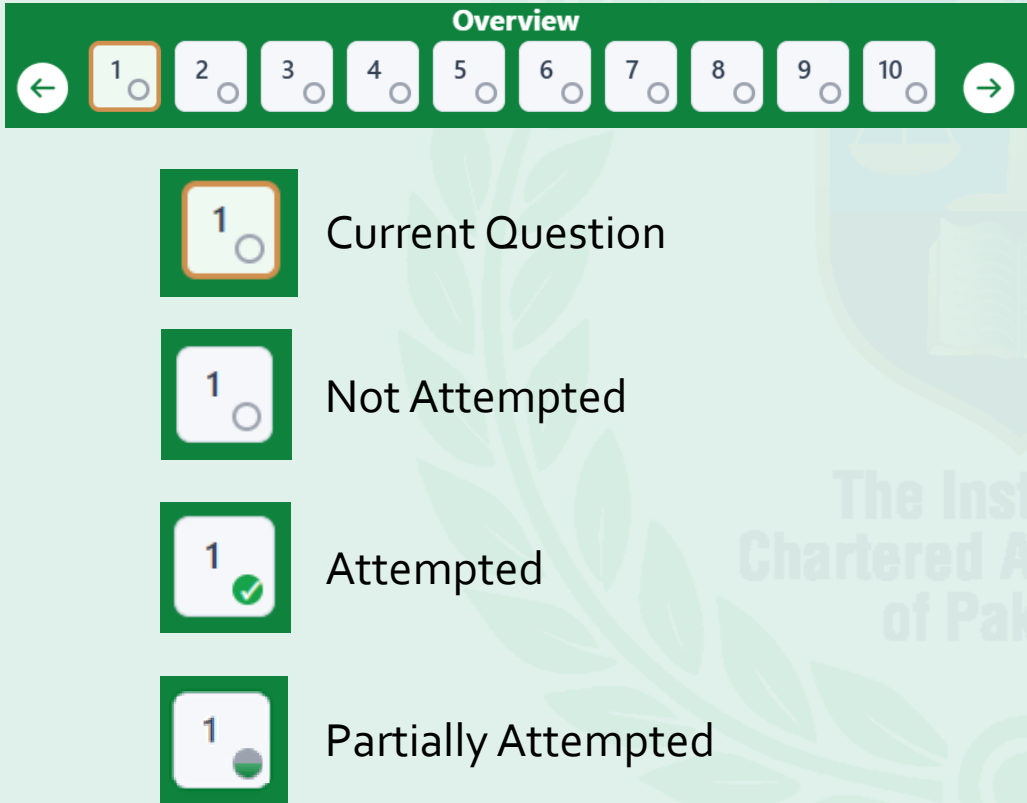

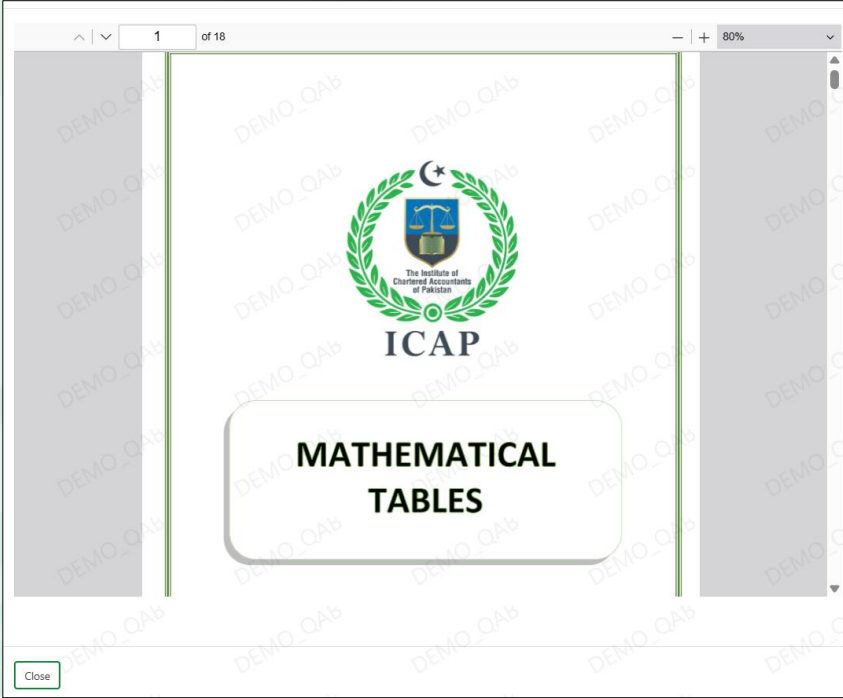

1	<div>Question Number</div> <div>Question: 1/50</div>	At the top left corner of the examination interface, you will see the current Question Number along with the total number of questions. This display shows exactly which question you are attempting and helps you track your progress throughout the exam.

2	Marks of a Question 	Just below the Question Number (shown at the top left), the marks allocated for that specific question will be displayed. This helps you understand the weight of each question and manage your time accordingly.
3	Action Buttons  <p>Note: The BACK and NEXT buttons automatically save your answer when you move between questions. In addition, you can press the SAVE button to make sure your answer is saved if you stay longer on a question.</p>	<p>The Action buttons—BACK, NEXT, SAVE, and END—are located to the right of the Question Number on the examination interface.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • BACK – Returns to the previous question. • NEXT – Moves to the next question. • SAVE – Saves the current answer securely. • END – Finalizes and submits the exam. Use only when you're ready to finish. <p>These buttons are placed prominently for easy access and smooth navigation throughout the exam.</p>


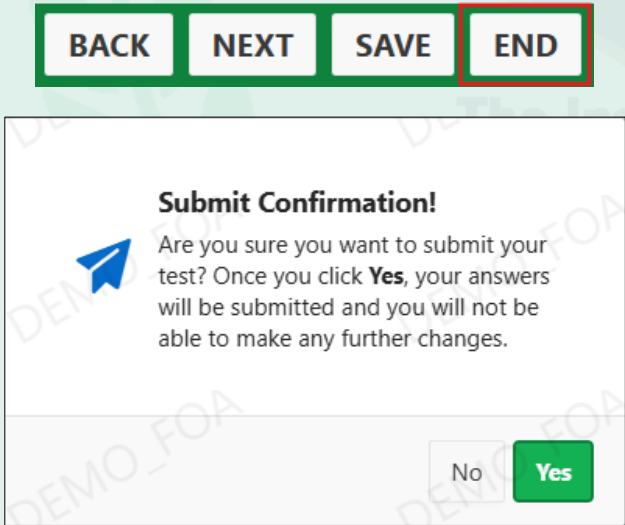

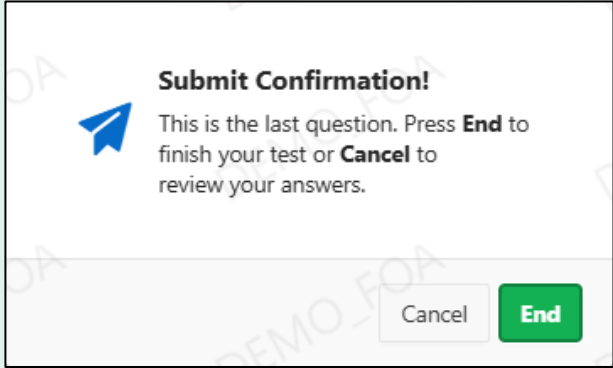
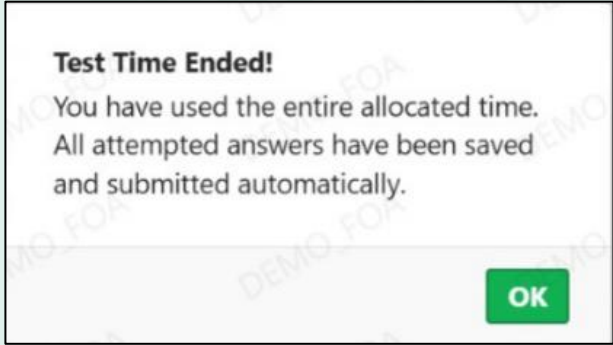

This feature allows you to mark a question for review, so you can easily return to it later before submitting the exam.</p> <p>Flagged questions are visually indicated in the Question Overview Panel, making it simple to track which items need further attention.</p>
6	<p>Notepad</p>  	<p>The Notepad is a built-in feature of the examination interface designed to help you organize your thoughts and perform rough work.</p> <p>It can be accessed from the top of the screen and is especially useful for planning answers, jotting down key points, or working through calculations before entering a final answer.</p>

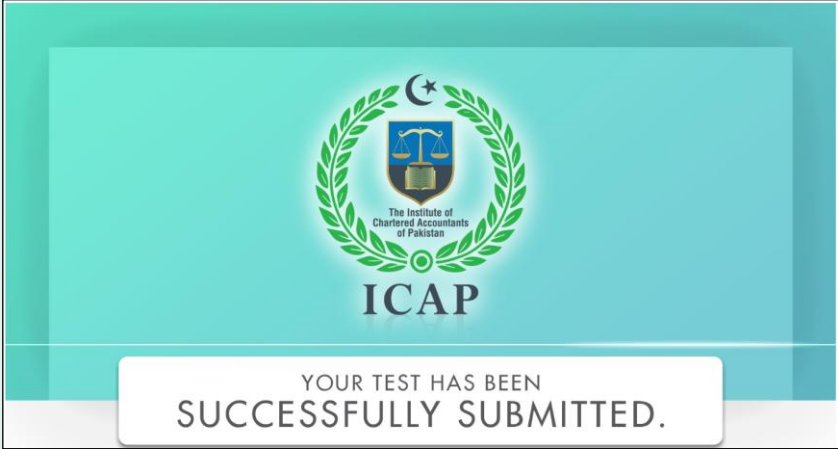

8	Exam Menu 	<p>The three dots icon (:) shows the Exam Menu that provides access to the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Instructions – View exam guidelines or instructions again. • Mathematical Table – Open reference tables for calculations or formulas. • Question Status – Show progress, including answered, unanswered, and flagged questions.

Flagged questions – marked for review.</p> <p>Each category includes question numbers and a “Go to Question” button, allowing you to revisit any question directly. This feature helps track progress and manage time effectively during the exam.</p> <p>Note: If you do not remove a flag from a question, your last selected answer will still be submitted as final.</p>

11	Clock 	A Clock is displayed at the top right of the examination interface, shows a countdown timer indicating the time remaining in the exam.
12	End of Exam 	When you click the END button, a confirmation dialog box appears asking you to confirm submission. Once you select Yes , the exam is finalized and submitted, no further changes can be made, and the system will automatically log you out. This action is permanent; use the END button only when you are fully ready to submit.
