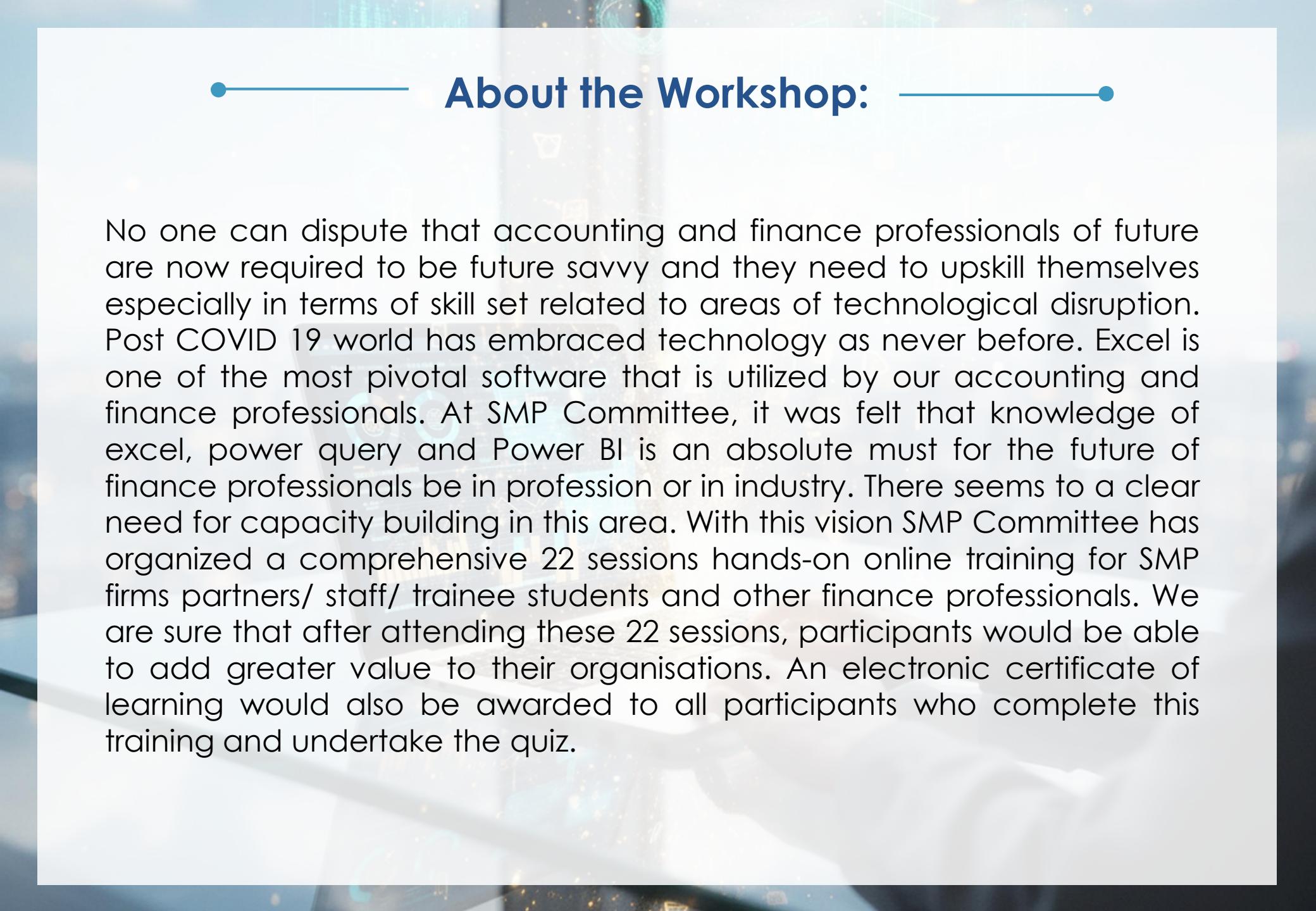

The SMP Committee of ICAP has taken many initiatives in last 3 years for capacity building of members in light with the strategy of the Council. These include the following:

1. SMP Audit Skills Enhancement Series – Training program on external audit conducted in 2022 and 2023 (Lahore, Islamabad, Karachi), 2024 (online), and 2025 (Islamabad).
2. Forensic Audit Investigations for SMP's (2 days workshop - Online)
3. Hands- on training workshop on RPA for SMP's and staff in Lahore, Islamabad and Faisalabad.
4. Data Alchemy – Online Hands-on Training Program (33 hours) for members, SMP firm partners, and trainee students, covering Advanced Excel, Power Query, and Power BI.
5. Audit Simulation Workshop – Four-day hands-on training on audit software, including the creation of a complete mock audit environment for a large company; conducted in Lahore and Islamabad.
6. Detailed Webinar on Audit Software – Online capacity-building session for members and trainee students.
7. Workshop on Preparation of Business Feasibility – Hands-on workshop.
8. Workshop on Taxation in Audit – Conducted in Lahore (in person) with virtual participation for members from neighboring cities; focused on the auditor's perspective on current and deferred taxation during audit engagements.
9. One-Day Boot camp on Sustainability Reporting – Practical training for students and members on IFRS S1 and S2 requirements, supported by real-time examples and application-based learning.
10. Two Workshops on IT Risk Assessment – Organized in coordination with ICAP's Digital Assurance & Accounting Board (DAAB), focusing on identification, evaluation, and mitigation of IT-related risks.
